St. Paul (1365) is separated from the St. Paul (Evergreen) Charge to become a station church. Sparta Hill (1350) and Shiloh (Evergreen) (1340) separate from the St. Paul (Evergreen) Charge to create the Sparta Hill (1350)/Shiloh (1340) Charge.

**Demopolis District:** Payne Chapel (2340) is separated from the Sweetwater Charge to become a station church. The Sweetwater Charge now consists of Sweetwater (2440) and Campground (2060).

**Dothan District:** Combine Old Tabernacle (3275) and St. Paul Enterprise (3380) to form the Old Tabernacle (3275)/St. Paul (3380) Charge. Combine Pleasant Ridge Enterprise (3310) and Tabernacle Hartford (3400) to form the Pleasant Ridge (3310)/Tabernacle (3400) Charge. The Samson (3345)/Corner Creek (3085) Charge is dissolved, and Samson (3345) becomes a station church. Corner Creek (3085) is joined to Westside Geneva (3430) to form the Westside (3430)/Corner Creek (3085) Charge.

**Mobile District:** The Deer Park (5095)/Minerva (5180) Charge separates into two station churches: Deer Park (5095) and Minerva (5180). The Calvert (5035)/McIntosh (5165) Charge is dissolved. Calvert (5035) becomes a station church. McIntosh (5165) joins with Mt. Vernon (5185) to form the Mt. Vernon (5185)/McIntosh (5165) Charge. The Crawford (5075)/Chunchula (5060) Charge is dissolved. Crawford (5075) becomes a station church, and Chunchula (5060) joins with Georgetown (5130) to form the Georgetown (5130)/Chunchula (5060) Charge. Pleasant Valley-Jesus Tribe (5200) joins Westside (5285) to form the Pleasant Valley-Jesus Tribe (5200)/Westside (5285) Charge.
